

A copy of last year's financial statement is available from the Treasurer if anyone would like to view it.

* Proposed budget - player rego costs this year \$150, which covers, \$80- ICSA player rego fee and insurance and \$60- WCOC costs (see Treasures report).

- **Nomination Fees \$200** per team per division
- **Ground Fees \$0** per team per division
- **Player Registration \$80** per player
- **Referee Payment \$25** per team per game

These fees are due now (\$150 TBC after I.C.S.A AGM). Depending on final player numbers this may not cover all cost (req min 28 players for two teams to break even for 22 rounds). Any budget surplus will be put back into the club for future clothing/equipment or team Bbq.

* Fund Raising. Does anyone want to help out by running the selling of Chocolates/drinks?

As mentioned above funds are tight and any extra \$\$\$ would help to fund players socks & shorts.

* New players to receive new socks & shorts. If existing players want additional socks/shorts they will be require to fund these themselves. Please advise Peter Hines within the next couple of weeks if you require these.

* Training ground with lights – JJ Kelly Park is an option, but it will be to the side of the Illawarra Stingray team that is training as per last year. Wednesday nights, 6pm.

* Running lines – If we have two sides again, a player from 1sts will be required to run the lines in 2nds, and someone form 2nds to hang back and do the same for 1sts. It is not fair to expect the subs to run the line.

A roster will be set up for the running of lines & washing of jersey's if volunteers don't come forward.

* Nets/posts - We need volunteer's to take home the nets and posts on a fortnightly basis. Committee members cannot do everything. Please help out.

* Proposed start date for the 2012 season is still TBC.

* The teams will be picked each week by Bryan Southall (coach) with the assistance of Stephen Moore (treasurer) only. Players are to accept the decisions made by the coach with no interference. (Committee members are volunteers & require our support).

* Request for post game, family friendly Bbq's & events were made. Volunteers are asked to contact a committee member to arrange an event. Families are to be encouraged to be part of the club through these events.

* ICSA has got a new line marking machine. Volunteers are required to help mark out the field every 10 weeks prior to the game (paint takes time to dry so not an hour before kickoff). If the field is not marked then we forfeit the games. Please help with this.

* The ICSA will be looking for a new committee next year so think about applying for a position. Those who run the clubs cannot be expected to run the Association as well so others are requested to step up and help. Without volunteers we don't have a competition so you have 12 months to think about it.

* Referees are required for the 2012 season. If you are interested contact the ICSA (\$50 a game is paid).

* Conduct – Players are reminded that we are playing for a Christian Church in a Christian Church competition. At no time is there to be any swearing or blasphemy (automatic red card).
